Three important questions come to mind when you think about life. What can they possibly be? Before dealing with these important facts of life, Pastor Rony told us a short story about Billy Graham and Albert Einstein at the start of his sermon entitled **Where Are You Going?**

Billy Graham, a renowned evangelist who has traveled and preached in almost every country in the world, told this story of Einstein. Graham is now old and struggling with Parkinson's disease which limits his mobility. At a luncheon hosted for him, he talked about how Einstein, while traveling on a train one day, faced a question he couldn't answer. He had misplaced his ticket and the train conductor was moving toward him. It was the conductor's job to validate his ticket and he knew there would be trouble if he could not produce it.

However, when the conductor came to Einstein and saw him frantically searching his jacket and pant pockets for his ticket, the conductor told him graciously that there was no need to look for it as everyone knew who he was. Minutes passed and yet Einstein continued to search for his misplaced ticket. The amused conductor repeated that it was not necessary. But Einstein knew he had to locate the ticket as his destination was printed on it.

What a pity, without the ticket, Einstein could not remember the name of his destination station. In short, he did not know where he was going. After narrating this story, Graham pointed to his new suit and told his audience that unlike Einstein, not only did he know what suit he would be in, but he also knew exactly where he was going after his time on earth is up.

Now, if you have no idea where you are going, then you are lost. To be lost is not a good situation to be in. Let us help you find your way with these three questions.

1. Who am I?

Everybody knows his or her name, but do you know that God created you with a purpose?

Before you were born, He knew who you were destined to be. God in all His greatness fashioned you with His plans in mind. God sent his only Son Jesus into this world as a human, so that He could experience all the hurts and disappointments of life. And then He would deal with sin by dying on the Cross and rising again on the third day to purchase us with His Blood so that we can be reconciled with God. Once you believe in this, you are a child of God. We find meaning in life when we know that we are children of God.

2. Why are you on earth?

You were born to share this wonderful news with other people around you. Without the knowledge of God's grace and salvation, the punishment of sin is eternal death.

3. Where are you going?

Once you believe what Jesus died for you on the Cross 2,000 years ago, you can be assured of your next destination – Heaven. It is written in the Bible as Einstein's destination was written on the train ticket. The promise is clear:

John 14:2-3 (NKJV)

2 In My Father's house are many mansions; if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you.

3 And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am, there you may be also.

I pray that this message will speak loud and clear to your heart just as it did this evening to the people who came forward to believe in Jesus. It is time to be sure of your destination.

After the successful declaration of God's salvation, many opened their hearts to receive the healing they had come for. Here are the night's testimonies.

Corie Lee found a **1.5cm lump under her armpit** in March this year. After visiting the doctor, she was told there were abnormal tissues in her left breast that warranted further investigations. During this time, Corie prayed and knew deep in her heart that the doctor would not find anything serious. Sure enough, there was nothing to fear as her results in

May showed that she was completely healthy. The lump also slowly subsided. Corie went on to tell us that she also received healing of her stiff fingers, which she had suffered for the past eight years, during one of the prayers offered for joint problems.

For one year, Benel Tang hobbled in pain due to **a sport injury that left the ligament in his leg stretched and loose**. Due to the injury, he was unable to move about normally. His leg was also visibly longer than the other one. Benel decided to come for the bone alignment prayer at the Miracle Service. During the prayer, he felt warmth in his leg but there were no obvious improvements until a month later. One day while

moving his leg, he realized it had resumed its normal range of motion. No surgery was needed even though the doctor recommended it. Indeed, God is the Father of all physicians!

A pinhole in her ear caused Annabelle Lim **to have an ear infection** due to fluid from the hole. Medication was prescribed to her to control the infection but it seemed nothing much could be done about the hole. She took her condition before Jehovah Rapha at the Miracle Service and prayed for healing. After two years of suffering, she is now delivered from the condition. The hole has sealed and there is no more infection.

Indeed our God is our Jehovah Rapha (Healer) and Jehovah Jireh (Provider)!
